

Tagajo High School “July-Heavy-Rain Donation”

The heavy rain occurred in Kyushu region and Chubu region, and affected mainly Kumamoto prefecture. Flooding of rivers and landslides occurred. It caused a great deal of damage with 82 deaths. At many points in the Kyushu, Tokai, and Tohoku regions, 24, 48, 72 hours precipitation were the highest number in recorded history. In addition, flooding occurred one after another in large rivers such as Chikugo River, Hida River, Mogami River.

There were 39,837 volunteers in the disaster area, and there was a lot of cooperation.

The members of the student council and volunteer club of Miyagi Prefecture Tagajo High School raised money and this was named “July heavy rain donation”. It was held for two days, and the final donation amount was 56,425 yen, with support from many people.

Also, some students wrote a message to students in the disaster area (It posted on the school's homepage. Please check!)

The donation was handed over to Japanese Red Cross Society from the Tagajo High School Student Council as a donation for “July heavy rain donation”.
