Tagajo high school set up “Tsunami height sign” around telephone poles in Tagajo, Miyagi. Tsunami height sign was set up by some students of Miyagi Prefecture Tagajo High School to show the height of the tsunami which occurred on March 11, 2011.

There are many places where you see this sign. This activity has continued since 2012 by Tagajo high school. To date, it has been put on about 150 locations.
